In September 2015, three RSCJ, Lisa Buscher, Kathy McGrath and Jane O'Shaughnessy began **Sophie's Well, A Center for Sacred Heart Spirituality** – a network of spirituality offerings to make Sacred Heart spirituality accessible to a broad range of people across the United States-Canada Province. As a team they organized: **Busy Person's Retreats** with over 250 faculty, staff and parents participating throughout the Network of Sacred Heart Schools; days of prayer for alums, parents, and faculty; training spiritual directors; and retreats with young people including monthly spiritual direction.



In this past year we have witnessed the election of Sister Barbara Dawson, provincial of the United States-Canada province, as the 17th Superior General of the Society of the Sacred Heart. We are honored to have Sister Dawson lead the international Society for the next eight years, and we support her with our love and prayer. We are grateful to Sister Kathleen Conan for her eight years leading the international Society of the Sacred Heart during these tumultuous years throughout our world.

We have been involved in the planning of the Bicentennial of the arrival of Philippine Duchesne, Eugenie Aude, Catherine Lamarre, Octavie Berthold and Marguerite Manteau in the St. Louis/St. Charles area in 1818. We have taken part in conversations with younger alumnae/i about their understanding of the Society's mission and how we can better communicate with them. Seventeen young alumnae/i from several Sacred Heart schools took part in the conversations with the mission advancement team and Sister Barbara Dawson.

The Conference of Sacred Heart education, with the exceptional leadership of Sister Suzanne Cooke as head of the Conference, and Ian Humphreys as program director, has completed its first year. Many inspirational and informative programs have been provided for heads of schools, trustees, faculty, administrators and staff.

Two new spirituality centers have begun at Barat House, Halifax, Nova Scotia, and Sophie's Well, a virtual spirituality project providing opportunities for prayer, reflection and discernment for those wishing to deepen their life with God.

The Stuart Center for Mission, Educational Leadership and Technology continues to offer programs for young people and adults to address the most pressing concerns of our time.

Many renovations on the 45 year old Oakwood facility have been completed, including renovations of bathrooms, bedrooms, hall ways, dining hall, kitchen, and phone system. The renovations, hopefully, will be completed in the coming year.

We are all grateful to Sister Barbara Dawson, provincial of the United States-Canada province for the past four years. We recognize her vision and daring and that of her team in all of the projects mentioned here.

Thank you for the many ways you continue to support the spiritual and educational mission of the Society of the Sacred Heart and the care of our elderly sisters. This annual report summarizes many of the exciting activities that we have experienced this year and that you have helped to support.

We thank God for each of you.





The Stuart Center's Leadership Academy helped these youth from ARISE (A Resource in Serving Equality) in South Texas to develop and implement their South Tower Power Campaign to address the environmental and health-related issues stemming from a waste treatment plant in their community. ARISE is a community-based program that works with low-income immigrant families along the Texas-Mexico border to help them create the future they desire and secure the opportunities they deserve for their children and their communities.



Fund Raising Income (unaudited figures)



Meeting People Where They Are

How do you stay connected?

Are you on social media? Do you communicate by email? Is your preference speaking on the phone? Have you written a letter lately? In St. Madeleine Sophie's day communication was through letter writing - she wrote over 14,000 letters. In the last 15 years so much has changed in our methods of communication and this poses new challenges and opportunities to continue growing in one of St. Madeleine Sophie's greatest gifts: an abiding fidelity to relationships.

We recognize that there are so many different members of our Sacred Heart family. What we didn't know was whether we were connecting and communicating with each of them effectively. So, this spring we conducted focus groups with 17 young alums who helped us to see the Society from their perspective. They told us that they receive pieces of mail from so many Sacred Heart organizations and they weren't sure how all these organizations work together. Many don't want to receive mail any longer and prefer going paperless. They talked to us about the importance of Sacred Heart friendships and how this is the mission in action for them. As we continue to advance the mission of the Society, we are learning to be flexible in our methods and means of communication in order to keep the conversation alive and vibrant.

As a result of these conversations, we are now trying to make sure that we are communicating with all of our family members, including our young Sacred Heart family members, in ways that matter to them. We have implemented an option for each member of our Sacred Heart family to tell us what kind of mailings they want to receive (www.rscj.org/subscriptionoptions) and this year we conducted our very first paperless annual appeal in addition to our mailed appeal. We are taking the advice from the young alums about the lengths of our emails and are structuring some of our communications based on their advice. Our family of the Sacred Heart spans all age ranges – from toddlers to centenarians.
